MINUTES

018/24 To receive and accept apologies for Absence

Apologies received from Ondrej Žačko.

In the absence of the Chair, BP proposed JO to Chair the meeting and DP seconded. JO agreed to Chair the meeting.

019/24 Declarations of interest and dispensations

i. To receive declarations of interest from councillors on items on the agenda

JO, BP, and DP each declared an interest as a resident of Crocker End

ii. To receive written requests for dispensations for disclosable pecuniary interests (if any)

The Clerk had received written dispensation requests from DP, BP and JO in relation to 020/24.

The Committee agreed to grant a dispensation to JO as requested

020/24 Agree on measures to prevent parking on "the triangle"

The Committee discussed implementing a 'haha' type solution on the area known as 'the

triangle' and a small length of the verge opposite, to deter vehicles from parking on the verges. The consensus was that parking would be pushed to Old Camp Road. The Clerk had sought three quotations. The Committee **RESOLVED** to accept the quote from The Landscape Group Oxford (TLGO). A shallow trench is to be dug around the perimeter of the triangle, with the excavated soil being used to create a raised mound along the edge. The verge opposite will undergo the same treatment. Over time, grass will naturally grow on the mound, providing a visual screen. The interior of the triangle will be rotovated and landscaped, with grass establishing itself over time.

021/24 Consider applying for a Councillor Grant for Byelaw signage

The Committee agreed for the Clerk to submit a grant application by the 29th November deadline.
